THOUGH SHIGERU BAN IS WIDELY KNOWN FOR HIS CURTAIN WALL HOUSE, FEW ARE AWARE OF THE VAST RANGE OF PROJECTS HE HAS UNDERTAKEN IN HIS SHORT CAREER. BAN'S WORK IS CHAR-ACTERISED BY THE INNOVATIVE USE OF UNEXPECTED MATERIALS AND THE HUMANITARIAN SPIRIT WITH WHICH HE APPROACHES HIS WORK.
